SALE OF GOODS ON CREDIT

Are your Terms of Trade up to it?

The priority provisions of the Personal Property Securities Act means, among other things, your retention of title clause (Romalpa clause) in your Terms of Trade is not effective by itself to enable you to recover your goods from the liquidator/receiver of any of your customers who fail.

You may need to change your business forms and obtain more information about your customers, and you will need to register your credit customers under the Act.
